Dead Presidents and Whales: Engaging Students with Nonfiction Text



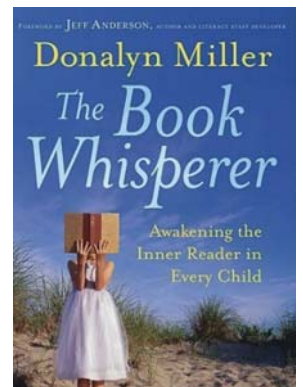
