(2.MD.8)</p>	<p>Skip count to 1,000 by tens or hundreds while jumping up and down or hopping on one foot. (2.NBT.2)</p>	<p>Create a story problem using addition or subtraction. Write an equation and draw a picture for your story problem. (2.OA.1)</p>
<p>Write the time of day three times this afternoon or tonight. Draw a clock with the time and describe what you were doing at each of these times. (2.MD.7)</p>	<p>Ask a family member to say a number from 100-900. For the given number, tell them the number that is 10 more and 100 more and the number that is 10 less and 100 less. (2.NBT.8)</p>	<p>Skip count from 200 to 400 by twos or fives while doing jumping jacks (2.NBT.2)</p>
<p>Find three objects around your house. Measure the length of each object. Draw a picture of each item, record their lengths, and write a sentence about their lengths. (2.MD.1)</p>	<p>Draw a group of up to 20 objects. Tell whether the number of objects you drew is even or odd. Write a number sentence for your number. (2.OA.3)</p>	<p>Draw a rectangle. Make rows and columns inside your rectangle and count the total number of square that you created inside the rectangle. Write an addition equation for your rectangle. (2.G.2, 2.OA.4)</p>
